Observations regarding overall institutional performance based on Student satisfaction Survey, Session 2018-19

Student satisfaction survey is a very important exercise carried out by IQAC, wherein students of various departments and batches are asked to fill an online feedback form. This exercise is carried out towards the end of each semester. The questionnaire incudes questions related to:

- **Teaching**: which includes regularity in Teaching, Practice of Tutorials/ Assignments, Coverage of Total Course and Overall Quality of Teaching
- Practical Exposure: including regularity in Practical/ Clinical Training, availability of Clinical
 Cases/Material/Industrial Exposure, opportunities for hands on training and Overall Quality of
 Practical/Clinical Training
- Infrastructure: including availability of AV aids/ICT Facilities, Library Facilities, Medical Facilities and Hostel/transport Facilities
- Others: which includes Mentoring, Opportunities for co-curricular activities and improvement in Communication Skills

• Overall curriculum content


There are 15 questions, for which the student has to give his/her feedback on four point scale with "Excellent" being the highest and "Poor" being the lowest.


Analysis is done for Odd and Even semester separately for each group of students. On the basis of Student satisfaction Survey carried out on about 400 students in 2018-19, following observations have been noted:


- Feedback of students from Pharmacy department is consistent throughout the academic session. Most of the students have rated the parameters as GOOD.
- Students of Architecture department seem to be overall satisfied with various facilities.
- Although the students of Department of Agriculture are satisfied with Mentoring, extra-curricular activities
 and the teaching course contents, yet the department has to work more to improve in areas like practical
 exposure and infrastructure facilities for students.
- Overall satisfaction level of students of BBA & BCA has improved, during the even semester as compared to odd semester.
- Students of Chemistry department were more satisfied by the facilities during Odd semester. Department needs to arrange counselling sessions for the students regarding improvement in some aspects.
- More than 80% students of the University are satisfied with the overall Course Curriculum of the respective departments. University departments may collaborate with industries for practical exposure.




Student satisfaction Survey, session 2018-19 Department of Chemistry










